

#### Cad is Ainm Dom? What is my name?

'Cad is Aimn dom?' is one song in a seven-movement suite for children, entitled 'Sevenses' and commissioned by Sing Ireland.

#### Performance note regarding percussion instruments

Since this movement is designed for use during the restrictions of Covid-19, percussion sounds are intended to be created from the items specified, all generally available at home or close by.

> A shaker is replicated by tapping a bowlful of caps from milk cartons. These can also be strung together and held in one hand, using the other to tap.



along an unopened can, e.g a tin of beans.

The 'jawbone' staff is for sounds made by drawing the handle of a teaspoon along a radiator or metal railing.

Closing the lid of a wheelie bin creates a suitable mid-range sound for the staff marked 'bongos'.

For the staff indicated 'djembe', two plastic bottles should be used. lying on their sides, and tapped. One bottle should be slightly smaller than the other, to create a difference in pitch.





A bass drum sound is achieved by hitting the body of an empty wheelie bin with a tennis ball.

#### A pedagogical note

This piece may be learned while children are learning about trees, Irish place names, the Irish language, or riddles.

Among the musical elements included in the song are: mixolydian mode, canon at the unison in two parts, use of a wide range of timbres in found sounds and body percussion, descant counterpoint, combination of metres of 3 and 4 time, call and response, and speaking the text in rhythm before singing it.

#### Text

#### **English Translation**






