Digital Resources: Use digital sheet music and rehearsal tracks to reduce paper usage and transportation needs.

Green Transportation: Encourage carpooling or public transportation for choir members to reduce carbon emissions.

Local Performances: Choose local venues and opportunities to reduce travel-related emissions.

Recycle and Compost: Set up recycling and compost bins in rehearsal spaces and performance venues.

Digital Promotion: Promote your choir's events and activities through digital channels to reduce paper flyer distribution.

Green Partnerships: Collaborate with environmentally conscious organizations and venues.
