Getting Rehearsals Online

First Contact

- Early closure
- Trustees/Committee/Volunteers Zoom call for planning.
- Two challenges: Getting people on. 2.What can we actually do on such a call?
- Initial phone contact to members to gauge response and viability

- Choir logistics and staying in touch


O Zoom


- Karen Meenan's 'how to' video and tech support desk
- First sessions Zoom call opened with background support calls getting people online
- Later sessions only occasional tech support needed



Expansion

- O Music Appreciation Sessions
- O Virtual Choir
- Promotional Video
- O Recordings with other artists







What Works on Zoom:

- O Music:
 - O Warm-ups
 - O Learning by ear
 - O Varying between use of clips and live accompaniment
 - O Inviting party pieces
- O Social Engagement
 - Participating in discussion musical related or otherwise
 - Seeing each other and being part of a bigger social event
 - Celebrating happy events, and marking others
 - O Long-term benefits
 - O Structure to the week
- O Mental health

What doesn't work on Zoom:

O Music

- Singing together
- Anything that goes on for too long
- O Social Engagement
 - Private conversations
- O Technology
 - General technology failures
 - Individuals having technology issues.



Getting Started

- O Research and visit choirs in your area
- O Form a committee
 - O Common goal
 - O Up front if possible
 - O Varied skills
- O Source funding
 - O Project plan and budget
 - O Start-up funders, later funders
- O Source members
 - O Parish
 - O Community organisations
 - O Local arts/sports organisations
 - O Word of Mouth

Musical Director Role


- O Various Skills
 - O Leadership, choral/musical direction, interpersonal skills
 - O Awareness of dementia

- O Responsive Approach
 - O Knowing your membership
 - O Repertoire responding and choosing
 - O Participation in concerts
- O Working with Members and Partners
 - O Members with dementia and their carers
 - O Committee
 - O Collaborators




Rehearsal Content


- O Warm-Ups
 - O Upper body: loosening and relaxation
 - O Posture and breathing
 - O Vocal exercises
- O Pacing
 - O Old and new material
 - O Work-fun balance
 - O Music-social balance
- O Other Elements
 - O Learning aids
 - O Rounds
 - O Musicianship / Ear training
 - O Songs from the floor
 - O Guests

Arrangement

Echoes, echoes



Strong Melodic Content

Light Harmonies Square Off Rhythmic Nuances

Arrangement

- O Choral Music
 - No arrangement necessary!
 - Retain the melodic line if a distinct single melodic line exists
 - Combining parts
- O Use of Instrumentation
 - Accompaniment support
 - Enhancing the sound
 - Pitching/Intonation
 - Filling harmonic gaps
 - Drawing from the membership
 - Professional musicians

Concert Preparation

O Music:

- Something to aim for
- Be ambitious but prepared
- Back-up plans

O Logistics:

- Transport
- Health and Safety
